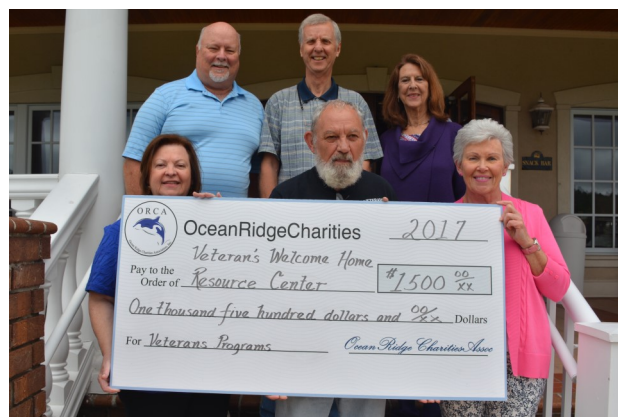
Veteran's Resource Center
